Through the guidance of our Public Health Officer, California Department of Public Health and the California Governor's Office, in order to minimize the spread of the COVID-19 virus, we are following the recommendations below:

Local bodies must still follow noticing requirements and implement a procedure for resolving requests for accommodation from individuals with disabilities.

Public comments may be submitted orally either through teleconference or in person.
